

Recovery and Recovery Plus+ Programmes



The programmes support children and young people across **Key Stages 1 - 5** to access a **broad and balanced** curriculum offer, and supports schools **to re-engage** their most vulnerable students. Our combined approach provides a **graduated response** that is tailored to individual children and young people that have experienced childhood trauma and a high number of Adverse Childhood Experiences.

In summary, we offer a combination of:

★ **In school or off-site** interventions - this offers the child or young person the opportunity to work with a **trained teacher**, to **break down** their **barriers** to learning, and ensure they remain at a **strong academic level** whilst maintaining and **rebuilding relationships** with staff and peers where problems have previously arisen.

★ **Community** intervention - it is often external factors that influence a child or young person's ability to **engage positively** with their education and LPW has a wealth of expertise at working with individuals and families to **support** them in their locality.

★ **Vocational provision** - for many children and young people the opportunity to **develop skills** in a particular area of interest acts as the **springboard** to educational engagement. We work with our partners to secure **opportunities** for individuals to put their skills to use in a range of **active learning** opportunities.

All **timetables** are adapted to suit the needs of each individual young person referred and will be **co-constructed** with learners' home school. They may also include a combination of **therapeutic work, targeted sessions** on child criminal exploitation or packages that support post 16 transition. Sample timetables are available on request, and are for illustration only.
